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## COMMUNITY RESOURCES

When a major illness such as cancer strikes, a family's resources are stressed. In the treatment of cancer, the financial resource of a family usually bears a heavy burden. A family, who has always been able to meet their financial obligations, may find this is difficult to do because of high costs of medical treatment. If the breadwinner in a household becomes ill, then the family may face the immediate loss of all income. This can seem overwhelming when a family is simply trying to cope with the knowledge of the illness. It is not hopeless though. There are things that a family can do.

It is important to know how personal resources can be utilized and what other resources are available. At this point, it is extremely helpful to rely on the experience and skill of a professional such as a Medical Social Worker, a Home Health Care Social Worker, or another professional in your community. These professionals will help look at a family's personal financial resources in relation to cancer treatment.

If necessary, it may be important that creditors be contacted and informed of the change in a family's financial status and ability to pay. With the knowledge of the financial stress caused by cancer treatment, most creditors will be willing to arrange a payment plan to suit all parties involved. It is vital that creditors know of a family's willingness to pay what is possible.

It is important not to let your current insurance lapse. If you have a group policy through work and will be unable to return to work, try to get it converted to an individual policy or seek C.O.B.R.A. information from your current employer about being able to continue your insurance coverage. If you are a Medicare patient, seeking doctors who accept Medicare assignment will lower your out-of-pocket expenses.
